

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Registrations will be possible from 1 September. Each of the organizations will then relay an email with the registration form to its network of activists.

The venue of the Biennale

The Biennale will be held on the campus of CERIA (Centre d'Enseignement et de Recherches des Industries Alimentaires et Chimiques) in Anderlecht, one of the 19 municipalities of the Brussels region. The site hosts secondary and higher schools and puts at our disposal its Jacques Brel audience (800 seats) as well as 2 other buildings and self-service for meals.

Address of the place: Avenue Émile Gryzon 1 in 1070 Anderlecht. Parking possible on site.

Accommodation

We mainly worked with the Youth Hostels present on the Brussels territory. The Jacques Brel, Génération Europe and Breughel hostels will welcome us in double rooms with breakfast. This accommodation will be completed according to the needs with other structures. The registration form that you can complete in September will allow you to express your wishes regarding the accommodation (with whom you may wish to find yourself). It should be noted that the organization does not support requests for accommodation in a room alone (or with an additional cost per night of 50 €).

Access by train and plane

The Gare du Midi is the international drop-off point, whether you arrive by train, at Brussels-Zaventem airport or Charleroi airport (also called Brussels South). From Brussels-Zaventem, the train takes you to the Gare du Midi. From Charleroi/Brussels-South, bus shuttles also take you to Brussels-Midi (to be taken directly from the airport terminal). A reception will be provided in the central hall of the Gare du Midi on Friday 28/10 from 16h and Saturday 29/10 from 8h.

Rates from 29/10 to 1/11/2022

For members of the organizing associations and partners: 180 € including participation in the biennial, meals except Sunday evening, accommodation. (Price excluding accommodation: 120 € If need additional accommodation outside the dates of the biennial = 50 € / night)

For exteriors, cost price: 330 € with accommodation, 240 € without accommodation.

These rates include participation in the biennial, meals except Sunday evening, accommodation if applicable.

Discoveries

In addition to the moments of workshops and exchanges, various cultural and artistic proposals will be proposed throughout the biennial, in the evening, but also during the day. On Sunday afternoon, proposals will be organized in small groups to discover Brussels with the possibility of meeting us in the evening for a cinema screening at the Jacques Franck cultural center. The program (with more than 20 proposals!) is being developed and will be submitted to the biennialists on site.

The Home Group

Since the end of 2021, a group composed of various Belgian Movements of Éducation Nouvelle has been formed to organize the hosting of the biennial. A good ten people are already working but will have to be joined by others at the time of the biennial to ensure meals, reception, logistics ...
